About Us

Daystar University was founded in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe, as Daystar Communications by Rev. Dr. Donald Smith and Mrs. Faye Smith, an American missionary couple, and Dr. S.E. Motsoko Pheko, a political refugee from South Africa.

The organization relocated to Nairobi, Kenya, in 1973 and continued to offer short courses in Communication and Christian Ministries.

In 1978, a Master's degree programme was launched in partnership with Wheaton College, followed by an undergraduate programme in collaboration with Messiah College in Grantham, Pennsylvania. In 1994, Daystar was granted a Charter by the Government of Kenya and became a fullfledged private local university offering its own academic programmes.

The name Daystar is derived from 2 Peter 1:19 which describes Jesus Christ – the Day Star that arises in our hearts. As such, members of Daystar University are expected to exemplify Jesus Christ in behaviour, lifestyle and speech.

The Daystar radiates light symbolised by the Brass Star whose illumination touches and resonates with the spirituality of the people.

The human form made from hardwood Mpingo which is indigenous to the environment and ecology in which Daystar Athi River Main Campus is set.

Made of a combination of local rosewood and typical Kenyan hardwood Mkafuri to express abstractions inspired by local textures of animal and plant life that dot the Lukenya plains.

The horn formation of the antelope suggests protection. Its commonness implies easy accessibility by the common people.

The metallic base of brass and copper also convey durability and continuity.

Overall: The rusticity of the timber expresses the human spirit

Order of the Towel



“The leader must be the servant of all”, Luke 22:26

On graduation day, every graduand receives a towel with the above inscription.

The Order of the Towel is a tradition adopted by Daystar University to model the servant-leadership ethos to our graduands. Jesus, as the model servant leader, used this action to teach his disciples the servant attitude that they needed to develop for them to impact the society they were called to serve. In humility, Jesus washed the disciples' feet. We do hope that each of our graduands will go out to make a difference through servant-leadership.

The order of the towel is also extended to Daystar University Alumni in the marketplace. Every year we invite the class that graduated 20 years earlier to honour them for living true to the Daystar University values in the marketplace. We present them with a fresh towel to remind them of our ethos of servanthood.

School of Nursing

The Candle Lighting Ceremony: This is an auspicious occasion in every nurse's life, held in honour of 'the lady with the lamp' Florence Nightingale, Founder of the nursing profession. It commemorates Nightingale's night candle-lighting aid for wounded soldiers during the Crimean War. It admonishes nursing students to shine light into the dark conditions of the patients they serve.

The Pinning Ceremony: Symbolically welcomes graduating students into the nursing profession and, specifically, welcomes them into the Daystar University School of Nursing and alumni professionals. During the pinning ceremony, nurses are presented with nursing pins by either the Faculty of the School of Nursing or by a person significant to them.

Historically, a nursing pin symbolizes an educated nurse who is prepared to serve society as a healthcare professional

The Nightingale Pledge: This is a statement of the ethics and principles of the nursing profession a modified version of the Hippocratic Oath done by Physicians.

I will do all in that is in my power to maintain and elevate the standards of Nursing. I will hold in confidence privileged information concerning patients and clients in the practice of my profession.

I will endeavor to work professionally with the team committed to the care of patients and clients, and devote my service to those in my care.

Message from the Company Board Chair

Beyond numbers; living the true meaning of impact

On my own behalf and that of the Daystar University Company, I bring this word of CONGRATULATIONS to the graduating class in this 48th graduation ceremony.

Your theme has captured my heart and mind deeply. The word “impact” is defined as “the action of one object coming forcibly into contact ,with another”. The dictionary also provides another secondary definition as,“ a marked effect or influence”

Themes are chosen with a focussed determination. “COMMISSIONED FOR IMPACT” is both powerful and explosive. Daystar University has prepared you for a mission that only you can engage. Each single one of our graduands are an impact on their own right. The need for impactful influence stands more clearly defined in our day than it was yesterday. In March this year, Scholar Media Africa (2025) indicated that each year in Kenya, over 60,000 students graduate from 79 universities and degree-awarding institutions.

I learned how to create fire, light and use appropriate accessories. The kerosine lantern light (still available) when lit, needed to be hang high in the room for everyone to enjoy its light. But after some time of usage, the glass needed cleaning

to clear accumulated soot. This was a regular activity if you were to benefit from the lantern services. As you let your light shine, attention must be given to the vessel of light. Keep the “glass” clean for ease of transmission of light.

I found some quotes that are sharable on the matter of light

- “In order for the light to shine so brightly, the darkness must be present.” This speaks to us on heavy implications. Being the light one is the enemy of darkness. should we find darkness, we also find the light is off. Some degree of dissatisfaction with conditions you find in the society must drive you to desire transformation. You must be stirred by the power of light within you against the darkness that betwixt our society.
- “It is better to light a candle than curse the darkness.” In this quote, I find the underlying principle that spells futile engagement with the status quo. Your impact will be felt not by the eloquent description of the darkness around, its origin and the perpetrators. Simply, SHINE, and you will be felt and appreciated.
- “Education is the movement from darkness to light.” Daystar University has provided the infrastructure upon which you will build deeper into the foundations of meaningful education. The University expects nothing less. (<https://www.brainyquote.com/topics/light-quotes>)

To Build Bigger and Better: A Christ-Anchored Journey Of Leadership

When I look back over the last six years, I am overwhelmed by gratitude — not for what I have achieved, but for what Christ has accomplished through our collective obedience. When I assumed this office, I prayed only one prayer: “Lord Jesus, if You lead, I will follow.” That prayer has sustained me in boardrooms and battlefields, in moments of triumph and in seasons of tears.

For leadership, as I have learned, is not a title to be held; it is a cross to be carried.

Faith became the cornerstone of our journey. We walked through uncharted waters, guided not by the assurance of sight, but by the conviction of faith. “For we walk by faith, not by sight” (2 Corinthians 5:7). There were days when the numbers did not add up, when the storm clouds thickened over our budgets, when projects seemed like distant dreams. Yet each time, the Lord whispered, “My grace is sufficient for you.” He proved that faith is not a retreat from reality — it is the power to see beyond what is visible.

At Daystar University, faith has never been decorative; it is functional. It is this faith that allowed us to envision a new Chapel when the resources were scarce, to launch a Spatial AI digital future when others doubted, and to believe in a generation of students destined to change nations. Each of these moments has reminded us that faith is not a doctrine to be discussed, but a discipline to be lived daily.

If faith was our foundation, then truthfulness became our compass. Truth is the fragrance of Christ in leadership. “You shall know the truth, and the truth shall set you free” (John 8:32). Truth in governance is costly. It demands that we speak plainly when diplomacy tempts us to disguise reality. It asks that we stand firm when compromise looks easier. Yet, truth has been our liberator. Through it we confronted our weaknesses, addressed our inefficiencies, and renewed our culture. Truth brings pain before it brings peace, but it remains the only route to genuine transformation.

These years have demanded sacrifice, the kind of sacrifice that does not make the headlines but makes heaven proud. Like David, I have often said, “I will not offer to God that which costs me nothing” (2 Samuel 24:24). There have been long nights, misunderstood decisions, and moments of utter loneliness. Yet, leadership under Christ has never been about comfort; it is about calling. It is about serving when you are weary, giving when you are empty, and forgiving even when wounded. In those quiet sacrifices, I found the gentle smile of God who said, “Keep going, My child, I am not done yet.”

Over these years I have come to cherish a guiding philosophy: that effective leadership must grow from soft hearts, strong minds, and endearing fortitude. Soft hearts to feel the pain of others; strong minds to discern truth from illusion; and endearing fortitude to persevere when everything in you wants to give up. The danger in leadership is not failure, but the slow death that comes from what I call useless virtue — the kind that sounds noble yet lacks courage to act; the moral paralysis that disguises itself as patience. Against this, Christ calls us to active virtue — faith that works, love that serves, integrity that leads.

We have also had to overcome inertia, that subtle resistance to movement which kills many dreams. Inertia says, “Wait until conditions are perfect.” But God says, “Move, and I will make a way.” Daystar University’s story is one of motion — from ideas to implementation, from prayer to practice, from dreaming to doing. We have witnessed the birth of new programmes, the strengthening of research, the expansion of partnerships, and the rise of a generation that refuses to be timid.

Timidity, too, has no place in the kingdom of God. “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind” (2 Timothy 1:7). The Spirit of Christ births courage to stand for truth, to innovate, to speak hope into despair, to be a University that refuses to imitate the world’s patterns but instead transforms them. We are not called to be cautious custodians of yesterday’s achievements; we are called to be bold architects of tomorrow’s promise.

At the heart of our future lies what I call the Virtue Proposition of leadership. The world speaks of values; Christ calls us to virtues. Values can be printed on walls; virtues must be engraved on hearts. Generosity, humility, honesty, compassion — these are not slogans, they are signatures of a life surrendered to Christ. The Virtue Proposition reminds us that success without character is hollow, and excellence without empathy is vanity. It asks of us not merely to be competent professionals, but Christlike servants whose conduct draws others closer to God.

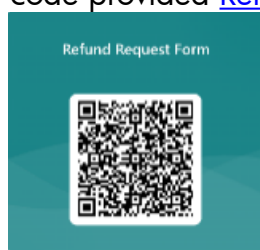
1. Fill the final clearance form obtained from the University Website.
