- 3.1 Once an offer is accepted, the full agreed price must be paid on or before the asset is collected.
- 3.2 If the full agreed price is not paid within 7 days of the offer being accepted, the asset may, in the absolute discretion of Daystar University, be offered for sale again.

4. Title and Risk

- 4.1 Title in the asset does not pass until payment of the full contractual price.
- 4.2 Risk in the asset passes to the Buyer immediately upon payment of the full contract price. Any arrangements for collection or delivery of the asset shall be at the Buyer's risk and costs.
- 4.3 Where the asset remains uncollected for more than 14 days after payment of the full contract price and passing of title, storage charges shall apply at a cost of Kshs 1,000 per day.
- 5. The sale of the asset shall not take place below the set reserve price.
- 6. The bidder with the highest quoted sum for the asset shall enter into a contract for the sale of the asset with Daystar University.
- 7. Daystar University shall not be responsible for any error in description of the asset (s).
- 8. Corrupt or fraudulent practices shall lead to automatic disqualification of a potential bidder.
